


Sumed International (UK) Ltd – Policy Statement for Safeguarding Children & Vulnerable Adults

Sumed recognise that Children & Vulnerable Adults are entitled to have their civil and human rights upheld and to live a life free from neglect and from physical, emotional or sexual abuse. They need to be treated with respect and dignity.

Sumed also recognise that all “citizens” have a responsibility for the protection of others and for sharing their concerns with safeguarding adult agencies.

All Sumed employees who may come into contact with Children & Vulnerable Adults will be trained to recognise possible signs of abuse and will be given clear guidelines on how to respond appropriately to any cases of suspected abuse.

Completion of a successful Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) accreditation (previously CRB) check, is a condition of employment for those members of staff likely to come into contact with Children & Vulnerable Adults.
